

Guide for S/W Update

USB Stick should be FAT32 file system. If not, USB stick can't be aware in the receiver.

Go to Utility > Media > USB > Scan > S/W Update. After Scan, you can see USB file list.



Upgrade S/W: Select a s/w file on File List and then press Green button.

Save data to USB: Press Yellow button to save user settings and channels data to USB.

Guide for cccamd & newcamd

1. Activation On


Go to main menu > press "5400" > activation on.

If activation is on, SACX V1.6 R mark will be shown. If not, it is not activation yet. Try it again.



2. Check the IP Settings

1. Go to Main Menu > Utility > Media > Network > IP settings
2. IP Settings > Choose DHCP in the DHCP/Static.
3. Try testing Weather Forecast or Youtube. If you see this, Internet is connecting.



DHCP and STATIC are the protocols used by network devices to obtain IP address, and if you want to change the protocol, use ◀ ▶ keys to select the protocol.(DHCP or STATIC)


3. Guide for CCCAMD

1. Take a look below example capture. Current capture has null letters, not server info.

Please edit text file with proper server information.



- Copy edited cccamd_test.txt to your USB stick.
- Choose CCCAMD in the Server Type



- Insert a USB stick and press RED button in the RCU



- Choose the text file in the File List and press YELLOW button for Update.
If the USB can't read, try SCAN again.



- After Update choose SAVE.

4. Guide for NEWCAMD

This is same as cccamd guide.

- Edit newcamd_test.txt with server information.
- Copy the edited text to your USB stick.
- Choose NEWCAMD in the Server Type
- Insert a USB stick and press RED button in the RCU.
- Choose the text file in the File List and press YELLOW button for Update.
If the USB can't read, try SCAN again
- After Update, choose SAVE.
- Take a look example capture. This capture has null letters, not information.
